

**CYCLOS**  
*Sparkman & Stephens Design No. 2447*

Designed in 1982 for George Herrdum, CYCLOS is rigged as an auxiliary ketch. She is an example of a modern super yacht with a colossal owner's aft state room with its own bathroom, shower and dressing table/desk, separate guest's double cabin, a chart area as large as many yacht's main saloon, palatial central accommodation. The huge auxiliary engine drives the propeller by V drive. The engine is completely isolated in a sound proofed central compartment, aft of the central companionway. The hull shape is a contemporary flat underbody with fin keel and the exceptionally tall ketch rig, triple spreaders on the main mast, is of a modern high aspect profile with comparatively short booms. The rig is carefully fractioned between the two headsails, the mainsail and the very large mizzen.

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
